DIY Foliar Fertiliser Recipe

For 1 Hectare:

• In a 20L bucket add 10L Biofertiliser Ferment. Other useful additives or substitutes include 250g Fulvic Acid (pre-mixed with water), 2L Fish Hydrolysate and 1L Molasses.

(can halve the rates for broadacre application)

- Top the bucket up with water.
- Add appropriate amounts of sulphate/salt nutrients for a 1 hectare foliar application i.e. 1kg Iron Sulphate, 1kg Manganese Sulphate, 50g Sodium Molybdate, 250g Solubor, 2kg Manganese Sulphate etc...to the bucket and mix well
- Fill the spray tank with water and adjust pH to between 5 and 5.5 as necessary with citric acid.
- Add 20L bucket contents to the spray tank.
- As an optional extra you can also add extract made from 1kg of good quality, mature compost.
- Add surfactant/spreader/sticker agent.
- Spray out in the early part of the day before it warms up or towards dusk when conditions are dry.
